A. Updates

Commissioner Burns and Chief Lawrence gave an update on the Knox Box and gate locks grant. EFPD will be applying for 25 locks and 3 Knox Boxes for an approximate cost of \$5,000. Chief Lawrence will be promoting for a joint lock/key plan for high risk and low risk locks. He will propose that EFPD be the administrator of purchasing the locks/keys if this plan moves forward.

- a. That the District purchased, and received, two additional iPads; Commissioner Burns suggested that Chief Lawrence purchase one more iPad so that each firetruck has one and there won't be the need to swap them out prior to responding to a fire call.
- b. The County will send one check for \$205,006 for the District's Fire Sustainability request instead of funding it on a reimbursement basis.
